Christopher Pezzullo is Maine's state health officer and represents the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention in the Maine Department of Health and Human Services. He has been practicing medicine for nearly 20 years in Maine as a pediatrician.

Pezzullo previously served as the medical director of the division of population health at the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention, beginning in 2012.
