## Administrative Readiness

Administrative readiness means the public health workforce is trained and has the right tools to complete their work as well as the ability and skill to perform foundational public health services. This readiness is a combination of leadership, workforce, funding, data, emergency response, communication, and more. Health agencies that can successfully supplement in-person meetings with intentional use of virtual platforms will enhance their administrative readiness through the following strategies.

Adaptability is a core component of administrative readiness. Strong public health leadership intentionally supports organizational infrastructure and policies that promote quick and strategic action on public health emergencies, changing political and funding landscapes, and ongoing operations to protect the public's health.
