



## 2014 State AMR Legislative Session Summary

State	Bill #	Summary	Status
CA	<a href="#">AB 1437</a>	Prohibits a livestock or poultry product from being sold in CA if it was administered a medically important antimicrobial for nontherapeutic use. Prohibits the administration of a medically important antimicrobial to a food-producing animal, unless for a therapeutic use and consistent with specified veterinarian provisions.	Failed.
CA	<a href="#">SB 835</a>	Requires medically important antimicrobial drugs to comply with FDA Guidance for Industry #213. Prohibits administration of a medically important antimicrobial drug through feed or drinking water except pursuant to a veterinarian-client-patient relationship. Revises requirements for registering medically important antimicrobial drugs with the Secretary of Food and Agriculture.	Vetoed by Gov.
CA	<a href="#">SB 1311</a>	Requires all general acute care hospitals to adopt and implement, by July 1, 2015, an antimicrobial stewardship policy that includes a process to evaluate the judicious use of antibiotics; to develop a physician supervised multidisciplinary antimicrobial stewardship committee, subcommittee, or workgroup; and to report antimicrobial stewardship program activities to each appropriate hospital committee undertaking clinical quality improvement activities.	Passed.
FL	<a href="#">HB 647</a>	Directs the Department of Health to convene a study group to evaluate and make recommendations regarding the efficacy of state surveillance, mandatory reporting, public notification, prevention, and response activities related to antibiotic-resistant bacteria.	Failed.
IL	<a href="#">SR 1183</a>	Expresses support for Congress to dedicate more National Science Foundation funds to antibiotic resistance research.	Failed.
KY	<a href="#">HB 460</a>	Requires health facilities to implement effective infection prevention programs and to report data on HAIs and MDROs; requires the use of an approved method of data collection and reporting.	Failed.
MO	<a href="#">SB 910</a>	Requires the Department of Health and Senior Services to promulgate rules to establish an antibiotic stewardship program for each hospital and ambulatory surgical center.	Failed.
NJ	<a href="#">ACR 165</a>	Expresses support for national ban of non-therapeutic use of antibiotics in livestock.	Pending.
NJ	<a href="#">SCR 122</a>	Expresses support for national ban of non-therapeutic use of antibiotics in livestock.	Pending.
NY	<a href="#">AB 4134</a>	Requires the department to develop a MRSA and infectious disease education program and an interscholastic wrestling health training and education program.	Failed.

NY	<a href="#">AB 5203</a>	Requires physicians to report instances of infections resisting antibiotic treatment or that may be MRSA infections to the commissioner of health.	Failed.
NY	<a href="#">SB 1689</a>	Requires the department to develop a MRSA and infectious disease education program and an interscholastic wrestling health training and education program.	Failed.
